

FATTORIA MANCINI

(Located in Pesaro, 18 km from Hotel Ambasciatori)

Fattoria Mancini is a winery owned by the family, founded in 1861.

The production is based on about 20 hectares of vineyards located in the Natural Park of Monte San Bartolo, in the extreme north of the Marche region. The vineyards are close to the spectacular high coast of Focara, a promontory overlooking the Adriatic Sea a few kilometers from the doors of Pesaro.

The main vine of the estate is Pinot Noir, introduced in the area at the beginning of the nineteenth century, but they cultivate also Sangiovese, Ancellotta and Albanella, a white grape typical of Pesaro.

During the summer season the Vigna di Rive is open to the public for aperitifs at sunset.



ENIO OTTAVIANI VINI E VIGNETI

(Located in San Clemente, 10.5 km from Hotel Ambasciatori)

Enio Ottaviani is a family business located in San Clemente of Rimini, in the oasis of Val Conca.

AZIENDA AGRARIA GUERRIERI

(Terre Roveresche is 57 km from Hotel Ambasciatori)

The farm Guerrieri is located in the middle of the green hills, surrounded by vineyards and olive groves.

For 5 generations they have been producing wine, extra virgin olive oil and artisanal pasta. Every day you can participate in free guided tastings of all their products and buy directly at KM0



TENUTA BIODINAMICA MARA

(It is located in San Clemente 12 km from Hotel Ambasciatori)

The history of Tenuta Mara begins when Giordano Emendatori decided to realize his great passion for wine, dedicating himself to the design and construction of an estate named after his wife Mara.

After the purchase of the land, in 2000, it took five years before the vineyard could be planted: seven hectares exposed to the sweet sun of Romagna. An area close to the hilly village of San Clemente, dedicated to a great Italian vine: Sangiovese.

Visiting Tenuta Mara means living an extraordinary wine experience, unique in its kind. A path lasting about two hours that, starting from the park and the works of art 'en plein air', continues in the vineyard, where the grapes that will become 'MaraMia' are born and grow.
